

GETTING A COURT ORDER FOR NAME CHANGE COSHOCTON COUNTY

What to File:

You will need:

1. Completed Application for Change of Name:

(Forms Adults: 21.0, 21.1, 21.5) (Forms Minors: 21.2, 21.3, 21.4, 21.5)

Certified copy of birth certificate;

3. Photo ID; and

4. \$78.50 filing fee.

Note: Bring a copy of your birth certificate as well as a copy of a photo ID, such as a driver's license or state ID, to the court with you.

Note: An applicant for change of name must have lived in Coshocton county for at least one continuous year before filing. Proof of residency is not required; however, the applicant must sign the Application for Change of Name, which includes a statement that the applicant has lived in the county for at least one year immediately prior to filing the application.

Where to File:

You should file in person at the Coshocton County Probate Court, located at 426 Main Street, Coshocton, OH 43812, (740) 622-1837.

Fees:

\$78.50 filing fee. You may pay with cash, check, or money order. Make check or money order payable to Coshocton County Probate Court.

Tips for Filing:

- · Use your full middle name instead of your middle initial.
- · The application forms can be typed or handwritten in blue or black ink. If handwriting, make sure it is legible.

Publication:

Notice of your name change application must be published one time at least 30 days before your hearing in the Coshocton Tribune. This will cost about \$50.00.
